Holidays in Term Time: If you decide to take children out of school in term time, it will be recorded as 'unauthorised' and your children's education will suffer as they will miss direct teaching time. In line with Cheshire West and Chester Council guidelines – If you do choose to take children out of school in term time your request may be refused and you may be issued a Fixed Penalty Notice. The cost of which is £60 – PER PARENT – if paid within 21 days and £120 if it is paid after 28 days. If the fixed penalty notice is not paid legal action will be taken by the Local Authority.

School Meals: From September school meals will increased to £2.30. The price has remained the same for the past 2 years, but the catering team have had to make a small increase in price this year.

Bus – Thank you to the group of parents who helped on the day the bus was delivered. It was a very stressful day and your support was welcomed. Thanks also to parents and relatives who have made positive comments about the bus and those who helped to clean the interior last Wednesday evening. The challenge starts on Saturday 14th July and continues until early September. All children can take part as long as they are library members. Children are challenged to read 6 books (or more) over This year's challenge takes place in the holidays. Beanotown, where Dennis, Gnasher and their buddies are on an adventure to discover hidden treasure. Children will receive a foldup map of Beanotown when they register and a set of clues to follow throughout the challenge.
