Reading Rainbow - Lots of children have been busy reading at home and have been collecting the Reading Rainbow Certificates. **Please encourage your children to read every day.**



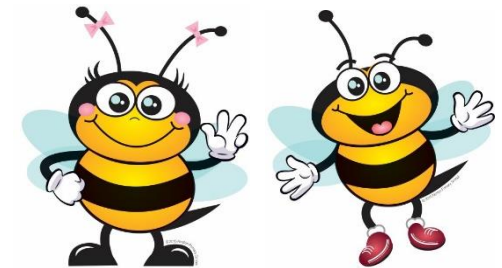
Ancient Greece - Year 4 have been busy creating their own Greek vases.
