We can click on the buttons or links when we know what they do.



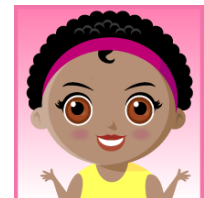
We can search the Internet with an adult.

We only take pictures and upload them if we have permission

We do not write silly or mean things about another person on the computers or when using any ICT equipment



Think before you send – always ask yourself 'how would I feel if I saw this or received this?'

e-Safety Rules for Key Stage 2

- We ask permission before using the Internet.
- We only use websites that an adult has chosen.
- We tell an adult if we see anything we are uncomfortable with.
- We immediately close any webpage we not sure about, and report this to the adult in charge.
- We only e-mail people an adult has approved.
- We send e-mails that are polite and friendly.
- We are always pleasant and polite when writing on our own web pages/blogs etc.
- We make sure we read through agreements on web sites and **make sure our profile is private**
- We never give out personal information or passwords.
- We never arrange to meet anyone we don't know.
- We do not open e-mails sent by anyone we don't know.
- We will save our chat conversations in case we need to show an adult something we are not comfortable with.
- We know where to go to report something that upsets us.
- If we use MSN/IM/Facebook/Bebo or similar **we only accept 'friends' we know**
