UNIFORM

Inappropriate shoes - converse shoes/high tops, uggs, brightly coloured trainers.

Trainers should only be worn on PE day.

Staff are going to be speaking to all children who are not in correct uniform and will offer alternatives - we have lots of clean, good quality uniform that has been donated as well as new PE kit in a few limited sizes.

Please support us with this. I don't like to nag but the children work better when they are in the correct uniform. Spare socks in their bag are also useful with the current weather.
