



MESSAGE FROM MRS ELLIOTT

As we approach the mid-point in the year I would like to thank all the staff for the hard work and dedication they put in to ensuring that the children have a positive experience at school. This is summed up with the KS2 residentials that are happening this week and involving 12 members of staff on the actual residentials but also staff remaining at school who have also contributed to the organisation. We will keep you updated of events on each of the stays however phone signal is not always successful at Conway. I will be attending the Barnstondale trip but Ms Thompson is at school if anything urgent needs attention.

Congratulations to all the children who won Champion of the Week certificates and School Values Awards this half term. We have all been really impressed with all our winners and those children who represented school at different sporting events.

ATTENDANCE

As mentioned at the start of the year, attendance is high on our agenda. If children are not in school, they cannot make progress. We shared our Attendance guidance information sheet in the Autumn term and this can be located on the website. We share your child's attendance with you at least 6 times throughout the year - at parents evenings and termly report cards. Mrs Furlong and myself meet fortnightly to discuss individual's attendance and whole school attendance is analysed termly. We send letters out when we are concerned about a child's attendance, meet with parents and set action plans to improve. After all this, if there is no improvement we then refer to the local authority. Despite all this, our attendance figures are significantly lower than I, the governors or the DfE would like. I am asking as we move into the second half of the year, do not keep your child off unnecessarily - if a child is too ill to be in school, we will not let them suffer and we will call you. The National expectation for attendance is at least 95%.

Oak Class have had some mysterious visitors laying strange coloured eggs in their room! Dragons have visited and been a fabulous stimulus for their writing this half term.


BOOK WEEK
